An explosion of creativity and vitality invades Mucciaccia Gallery Singapore with 'Vibrations: The Energy of Contemporary Art', an exhibition bringing together five international artists whose works pulsate with energy, colour and innovation. From January 14, 2025 to February 28, 2025, the public is invited to immerse themselves in a kaleidoscope of styles and techniques, from performance art to painting, in a stimulating dialogue between diverse artistic expressions.

The exhibition presents an exciting array of works by five remarkable artists, each bringing a distinct and dynamic energy to the showcase. From historical performance art to vibrant abstract compositions, this exhibition celebrates the power of creativity and its capacity to connect with audiences on a sensory level.

Shozo Shimamoto, a master of performance art and a pioneer of the Gutai movement, infuses the exhibition with his disruptive energy. Through documentations of historical performances and works exploring material and pictorial gestures, Shimamoto's artistic practice, often involving the throwing of colour onto canvas, embodies a vital and primordial force.



Philip Colbert introduces a pop and surrealist dimension with his unique iconographic universe, populated by anthropomorphic lobsters and pop culture references. His vibrant, irony-laden works exude playful energy, offering a refreshing perspective on contemporary art.

Jeffrey Kroll's pieces stand out for their vivid use of colour and abstract compositions that evoke inner landscapes and emotional states. His gestural and material approach to painting resonates deeply, conveying a powerful and emotive energy.

Frank Holliday's canvases burst with colour and movement, characterised by energetic brushstrokes and dynamic compositions. Influenced by abstract expressionism, his works radiate a sense of vitality and immediacy, captivating viewers with their dynamism.

Cristiano Pintaldi's exploration of abstract and geometric language pushes the boundaries of painting, creating works that shimmer with light and colour. His precise, refined compositions generate an intense visual energy, immersing the audience in a captivating interplay of form and light.

'Vibrations' is not merely an exhibition but a sensory experience that invites the audience to connect with the pulsating energy of contemporary art. This is a rare opportunity to engage with the work of five visionary artists who, through their creativity, are redefining the current art scene.
